Professor Takeya extensive experience in Disaster Risk Reduction and Reconstruction Policy got him appointed as Distinguished Technical Advisor to the President of the Japan International Cooperation Agency, JICA. In addition, he serves on the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change (UNFCCC) Warsaw International Mechanism Executive Committee for Loss and Damage associated with Climate Change Impacts.

Professor Takeya was a main contributor from the Japanese Government to the formulation of Sendai Framework for DRR 2015-2030 which links strongly with both the Paris Agreement and the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs). The Sendai Framework was a significant milestone in international cooperation for building resilience to climate-related disaster.
